Research Coordination

Texas Health Research & Education Institute is the research and education arm of Texas Health Resources. We facilitate and conduct clinical and pre-clinical research throughout Texas Health, one of the nation's largest faith-based, nonprofit health care delivery systems. We advance patient care through translational research, including research and clinical trials in varied specialties, product evaluation, proof of concept testing and product development.

CLINICAL AND PRE-CLINICAL TRIALS

Texas Health Research & Education coordinates approximately 200 research studies across the Texas Health system. Study topics range across the clinical research spectrum. Current studies focus on areas such as cardiac, gastrointestinal and trauma.

Services we provide in facilitating and conducting research include:

- Protocol design and development
- Study initiation
- Database design and management
- Site management
- Regulatory reporting

RESEARCH GRANTS AND CONTRACTS

We help researchers through seeking, identifying and announcing research grant opportunities. Our grants office facilitates grant submissions, and manages grant contracts and research studies.

RESEARCH COMPLIANCE

Research across Texas Health Resources is coordinated through the systemwide Institutional Review Board (IRB). The consolidated IRB reviews, approves and monitors research involving human subjects at Texas Health Resources.

The Texas Health Minimally Invasive Technology Center, operated by Texas Health Research & Education, provides research and training capabilities for both Texas Health-affiliated physicians and physicians affiliated with other institutions.
