### Is the COVID-19 vaccine dangerous for teens?

No. There's no current evidence that the COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer) is dangerous for children 12-17.



### Why do teens need to get vaccinated against COVID-19?

COVID-19 is still a threat to people who are not vaccinated. Teens can still get infected with the virus, and just as importantly, transmit it to other people.



### Can the COVID-19 vaccine impact puberty, menstruation, and fertility?

There is currently no clinical evidence to suggest the vaccines can have long-term effects on puberty, menstruation, or fertility.
