

# Emergency Department Visitor Information

One visitor per patient may be allowed in the Emergency Department.

## Visitor Guidelines:

- One visitor is allowed for patients who do not have COVID-19 or are not suspected of having COVID-19
- No visitors for COVID-19 patients (positive or suspected positive), except for special circumstances\*
- Visitors are not allowed to wait in the waiting room
- The visitor is allowed to stay in the patient room overnight, and may remain with patient if they are admitted to the hospital, regardless of the time
- Visitation may become restricted if patient's status changes
- Visitation may be limited if the patient's COVID-19 status changes
- Visitor hours are not restricted

## Visitors Must:

- Remain in patient room at all times
- Wear the hospital-provided wristband and face mask at all times—even when in patient room
- Keep a safe distance from others
- Practice good handwashing
- Follow all hospital staff instructions



\* Visitor exceptions may be considered for special situations, such as labor & delivery, disabilities or impairments, or end-of-life.
