Proven to be safe

Thousands of people from many backgrounds were part of the large safety test trials.



Protects your family

Especially important for high-risk family members like older adults and those with medical conditions like asthma, cancer, COPD, heart conditions, sickle cell disease, or obesity, and women who are pregnant.



Can help keep you healthy so you can keep working

The vaccine lowers the chance of getting COVID-19 which means less chance of missing work in the future.

3 Things You Should Know About the COVID-19 Vaccine

You might have mild side effects, but that is normal.

Some people will experience side effects for a day or two like pain or swelling in the arm, fever, chills, headaches and fatigue. This is normal, and just means your immune system is working.

There is NO cost for the vaccine - it's FREE!

It is free at most locations. Register for the vaccine with a county convenient to you to be sure that you won't pay any fees.

You can't get COVID-19 from the vaccine.

There is no COVID-19 in the vaccine. The vaccine helps you build antibodies against COVID-19, helping your body's immunity to the virus without having to get the illness.

REGISTER FOR THE VACCINE LIST

North Texans can sign up online with their county or at any county convenient to them.

WAIT TO BE CONTACTED

The county will contact you when it is your turn for the vaccine and tell you where to go.



UNDERSTAND YOUR RISK

Those with higher risk based on age, medical conditions or other factors will be moved to the front of the line.
