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“Advance Care Planning: What I need to know”

Advance care planning is the process of preparing legal documents that allow you to name someone to speak for you and make your medical decisions if you cannot speak for yourself. No matter your age or circumstances, this course will help you complete legal documents to communicate your wishes to your loved ones and medical care providers.
