
How to Document: Infant Maternal Health

Here are some tips to help. See screenshots for details. Please include individual documentation. How will maternal health numbers be pulled if combined with non-maternal health?


1. <u>Blood Pressure clinic</u>. Complete as normal, just add in the notes how many people you saw that were pregnant or one year post pregnancy. If you do any other activity under Screening that impact Maternal Health. Just add a note/comment.



2. <u>Food Pantries</u>: Most <u>food pantries</u> enter information in the (Screening, Nutritional section) or (support group, Food/Meals if they serve meals). If you have pregnant people that you are hosting, please include this in the note section. If you do or do not provide infant food or formula, please note that. This is valuable information
