



Double Up Food Bucks

Double Up Food Bucks allows anyone eligible for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits to double their buying power when purchasing fresh produce at participating grocers and farmers markets. At grocers, participants receive 50% off fresh produce when using their Lone Star Card (EBT). At farmers markets, SNAP purchases are matched \$1 for \$1 in Food Bucks, valid for more fresh fruits and vegetables. Contact each market directly for operating hours.
