In accordance with the policy of the Transplant Program at Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth, every patient is to be notified of the Transplant Program's selection criteria. Absolute Exclusion:

- o Severe disabling cardiovascular and/or pulmonary disease
- o Active malignancy
- o Severe disabling vascular disease
- Severe disabling liver disease
- o HIV positive
- o Life expectancy of less than 5 years
- o Inability to obtain adequate financial resources
- Potential recipient is unable or unwilling to comply with transplant related management and medical follow up.
- BMI greater than 45

Relative Exclusion (Evaluated on a case by case basis):

- Poor functional capacity (wheelchair bound or 6-minute walk less than 1000 feet)
- Psychosocial instability
- Documented non-compliance
- o Obesity considered with weight distribution and co-morbidities
- Anatomy that may predispose recipient to excessive surgical risk
- o Active substance abuse
- Current smoking with concurrent clinically demonstrable cardiovascular and/or pulmonary disease
- o Recent history of cancer
- o BMI 40-45
- o Multiple Co-Morbidities
