A statistician can help you determine the appropriate study design, including sample size, randomization techniques, and data collection methods. They can help you select appropriate statistical methods, interpret results, and provide valuable input on how to analyze and present your data.

Data

THR has a **Research Data Analytics team** that can assist you will pulling large amounts of data from the electronic medical record for your study. They additionally can assist with providing high level data for preparatory to research activities. However, you can additionally pull high level data for you preparatory to research activities via Epic's Slicer Dicer. See the "**HB Slicer Dicer**" training document.

To request data from the **Research Data Analytics team**:

Go to the Service Desk portal → Submit an IT Request → You can use the search word "Research" and select "Reporting Services" → click the checkbox for "Research Reporting Services" → select "Next" → Select the "Options" → Then you should see all of the questions for the ticket.
