Dr. Benjamin Levine Receives Established Investigator Award

Benjamin Levine, M.D., a Professor in the Division of Cardiology and Director of the Institute for Exercise and Environmental Medicine (IEEM), has received the Michael L. Pollock Established Investigator Award from the American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation in recognition of his outstanding work in the field of cardiology.

The award is presented to individuals who have made significant advances in the field of cardiac rehabilitation through their research and scholarly contributions and have earned national prominence through contributions to contemporary research and education.

Dr. Levine founded the IEEM at Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital Dallas in 1992, which has become one of the premier laboratories in the world for the study of human clinical and integrative physiology. In addition to his clinical practice and research activities, he is a renowned sports cardiologist with a unique background in space medicine.

Dr. Levine joined the UT Southwestern faculty in 1990.

Dr. Levine holds the Distinguished Professorship in Exercise Sciences.
