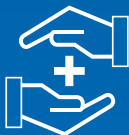

Opened **6** additional Texas Health Breeze Urgent Care[™] clinics.



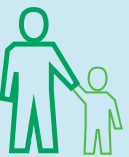
CARING FOR OUR EMPLOYEES
